Simple Present

[to like]

I like.
You like.
He likes.
We like.
You like.
They like

Simple Past

[to need]

I needed
You needed
He needed
We needed
You needed
They needed

Present Negative
[to look]

I do not look.
You do not look.
He does not look.
We do not look.
You do not look.
They do not look.

Past Negative
[to work]

I did not work
You did not work
She did not work
We did not work
You did not work
They did not work

Question Form: [to speak] :

Do I speak?
Do you speak?
Does she speak?
Do we speak?
Do you speak?
Do they speak?

Question Form [to ask]

Did I ask?
Did you ask?
Did he ask?
Did we ask?
Did you ask?
Did they ask

Vocabulary

Ask: request (someone) to do or give something.

Call: a cry or sound to attract someone's attention.

Help: to do something by offering one's services or resources.

Give: to hand over to.

Go: to move from one place to another

Make: cause (something) to exist or come about; bring about

Play: engage in activity for enjoyment and recreation

Tell: communicate to someone in spoken or written words

Use: to put into action or service

Work: be engaged in physical or mental activity in order to achieve a purpose.
