Vocabulary

Beautiful: Someone with a pleasing appearance.

e.g. She is a beautiful woman.

Brave: Someone who is not afraid of danger.

e.g. John is brave firefighter.

Busy: Someone who has a lot to do, occupied.

e.g. Mike and Carl are always busy.

Cool: Someone who is fashionable, impressive or calm.

e.g. The actor is cool on tv.

Friendly: Someone who is nice to other people

e.g. You are a friendly person.

Funny: Someone who is amusing

e.g. My friend is not a funny person.

Tired: Someone who needs to rest or sleep

e.g. Are you tired?

Sleepy: Someone who needs or is ready for sleep

e.g. The baby is sleepy.

Lazy: Someone who does not like to work

e.g. The cat is lazy.

Happy: Someone who is feeling positive or pleasant

e.g. The baby is happy to see her mother.
