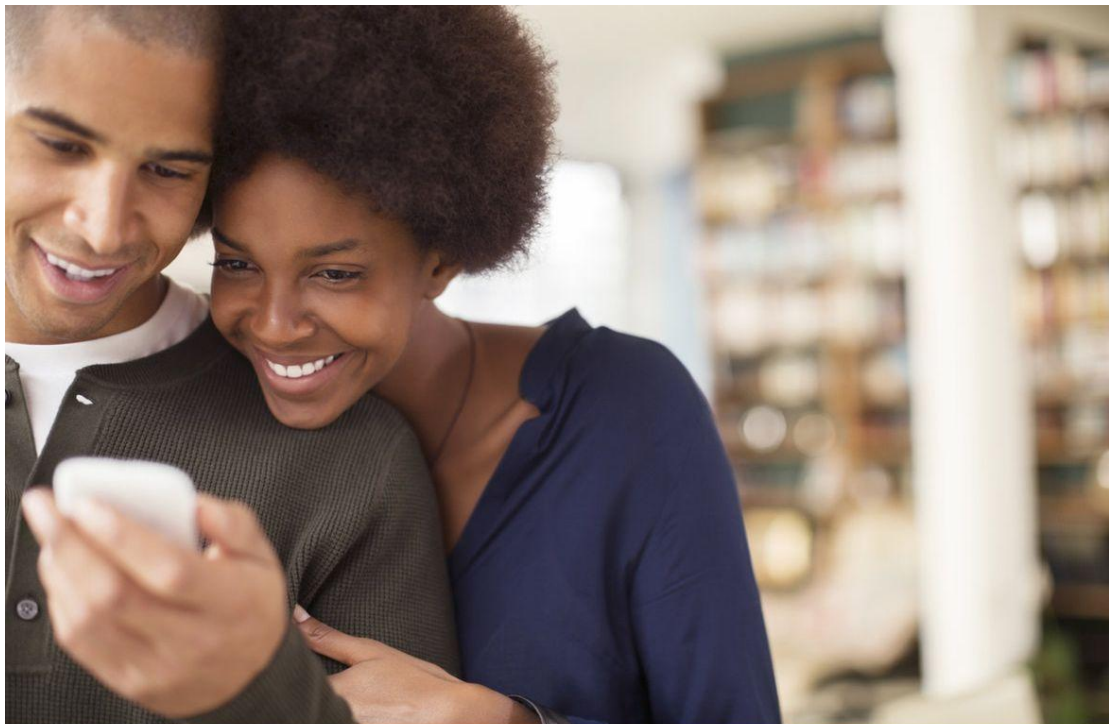


Lesson 8 There is something about you.

in English- Level 1

[There] + [be] + [object]

There is a picture of my friend.



We use ***there is*** to describe the existence of something. The verb ***to be*** has to agree with the noun that follows it.

Present : [There] [is] [*a dog* outside].

Plural : [There] [are] [*pens* on the table]

Past : [There] [was] [*a person* at the door]

Plural : [There] [were] [*animals* at the zoo]

Future : [There] [will be] [*an event* next week]

Question: Is there a dog outside?
Are there pens on the table?
Was there a person at the door?
Will there be an event next week?

Negative : There is no paper on the desk
There are no shoes in the house.

Pronunciation

There are kids in the building.

There is no water here.

There was a crazy man in the terminal.

There were 7 members in the band.

There will be a show tomorrow.

Is there a restroom here?

Is there an extra hoodie?
