Present: Helen is the shortest person here.

Past: She was the oldest of the sisters.

Question: Is this car the fastest in the world?

Superlatives That Add -est

Big - biggest
Cheap- cheapest
Brave - bravest
Bright - brightest
Cheap - cheapest
Clean - cleanest
Cold - coldest
Nice - nicest
Proud - proudest
Quiet - quietest
Rich - richest

Superlatives That Change the "y" to an "i" and Add -est

Angry - angriest
Bossy - bossiest
Busy - busiest
Classy - classiest
Dirty - dirtiest
Early - earliest
Easy- easiest
Skinny - skinniest
Smelly - smelliest
Wealthy - wealthiest

Superlatives That Add Most or Least

Beautiful - most beautiful
Famous - most famous
Gullible - most gullible
Immense - most immense
Perfect - least perfect
Powerful - least powerful
Wonderful - most wonderful
Upset - least upset

Irregular Adjective Forms

Bad - worse - worst

Far - further - furthest (meaning additional, not distance)

Good - better - best

Little - less - least

Many - more - most

Old - elder - eldest (for people in a family or group)
